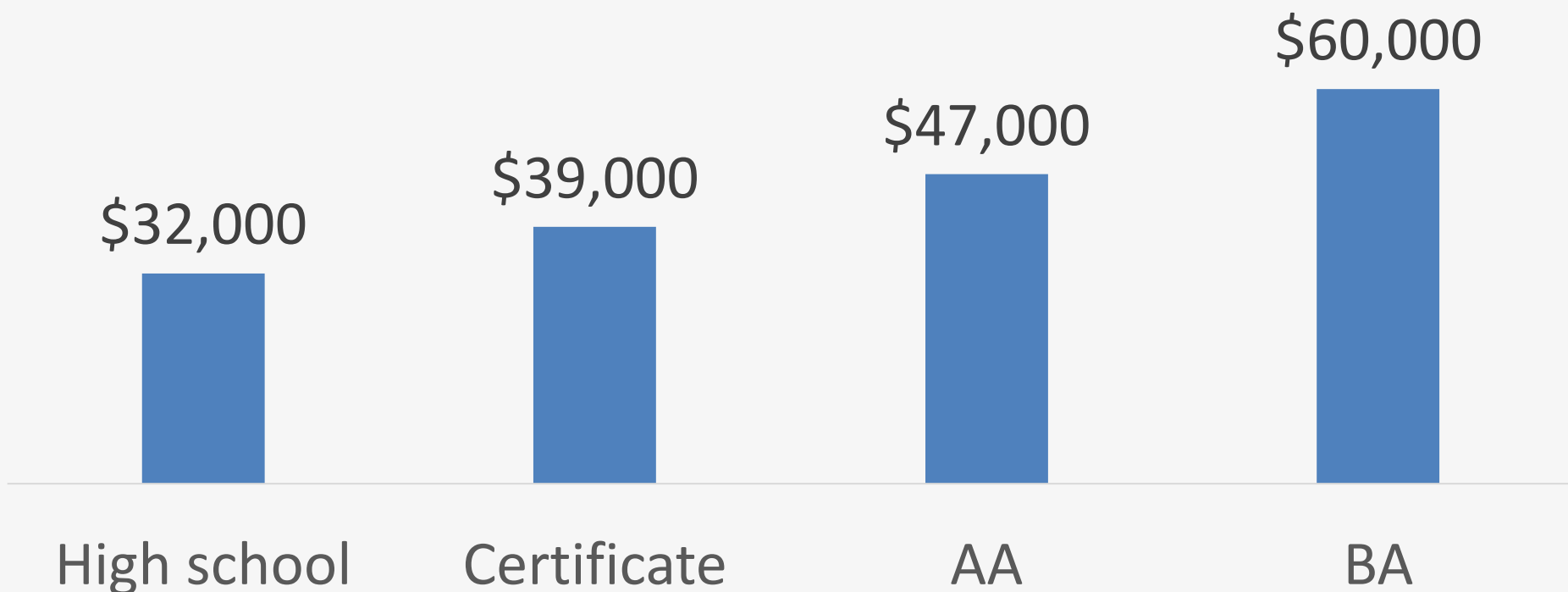
The Forgotten Half

Out of 10 high school freshmen,

- 5 don't complete a postsecondary credential:
 - 2 drop out of high school;
 - 1 graduates high school but doesn't enroll in a postsecondary program;
 - 2 enroll in a postsecondary program but drop out;
- 2 complete an AA/certificate;
- 3 complete a BA.

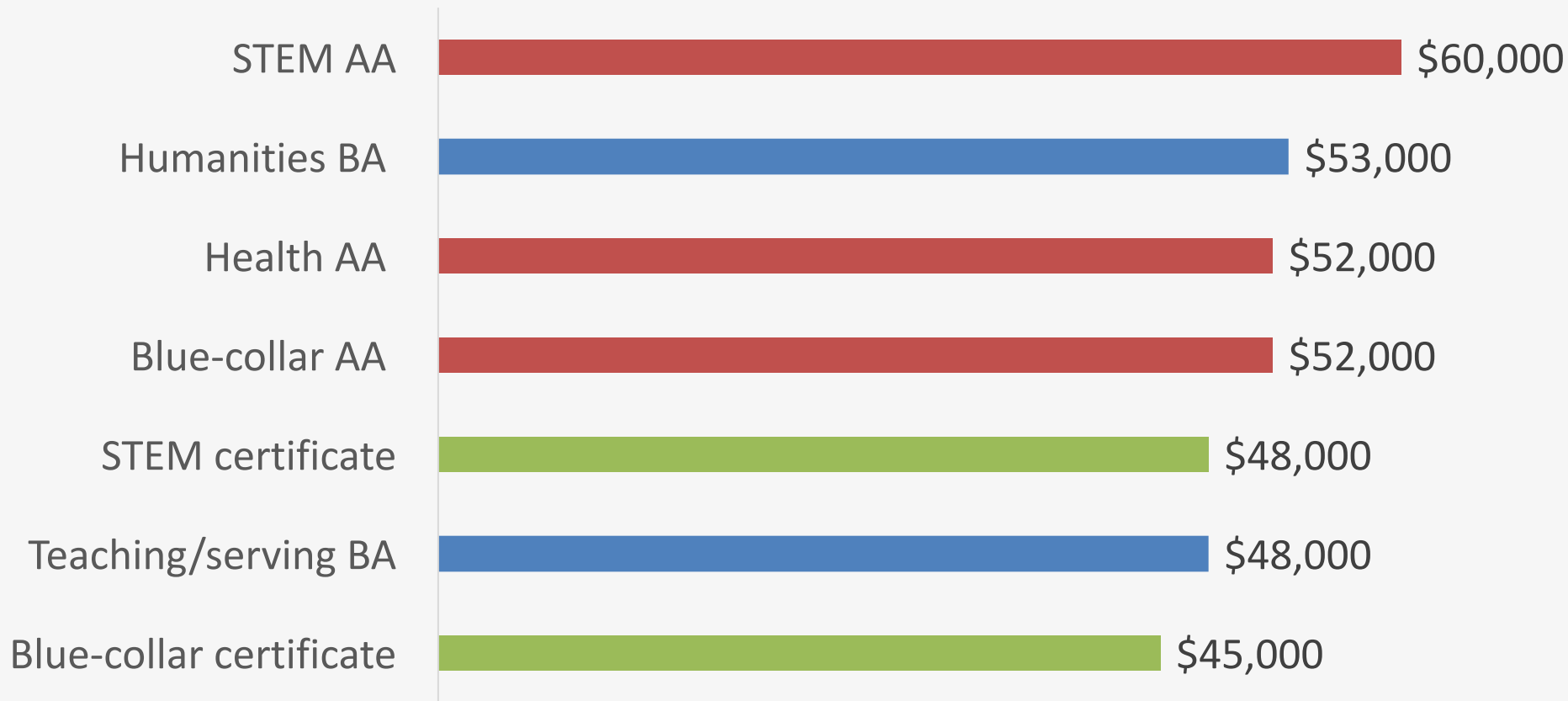
Median annual earnings (2015\$)

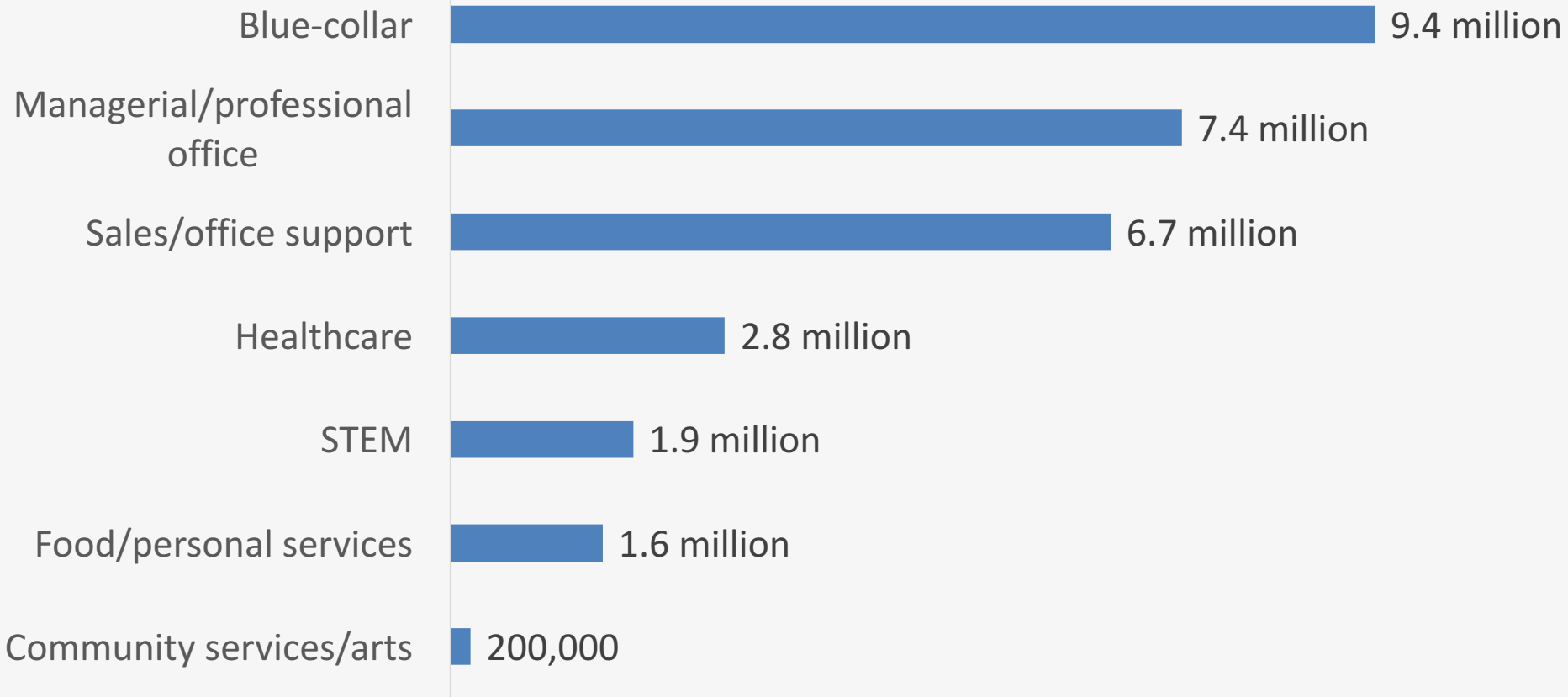


Median annual earnings (2015\$)

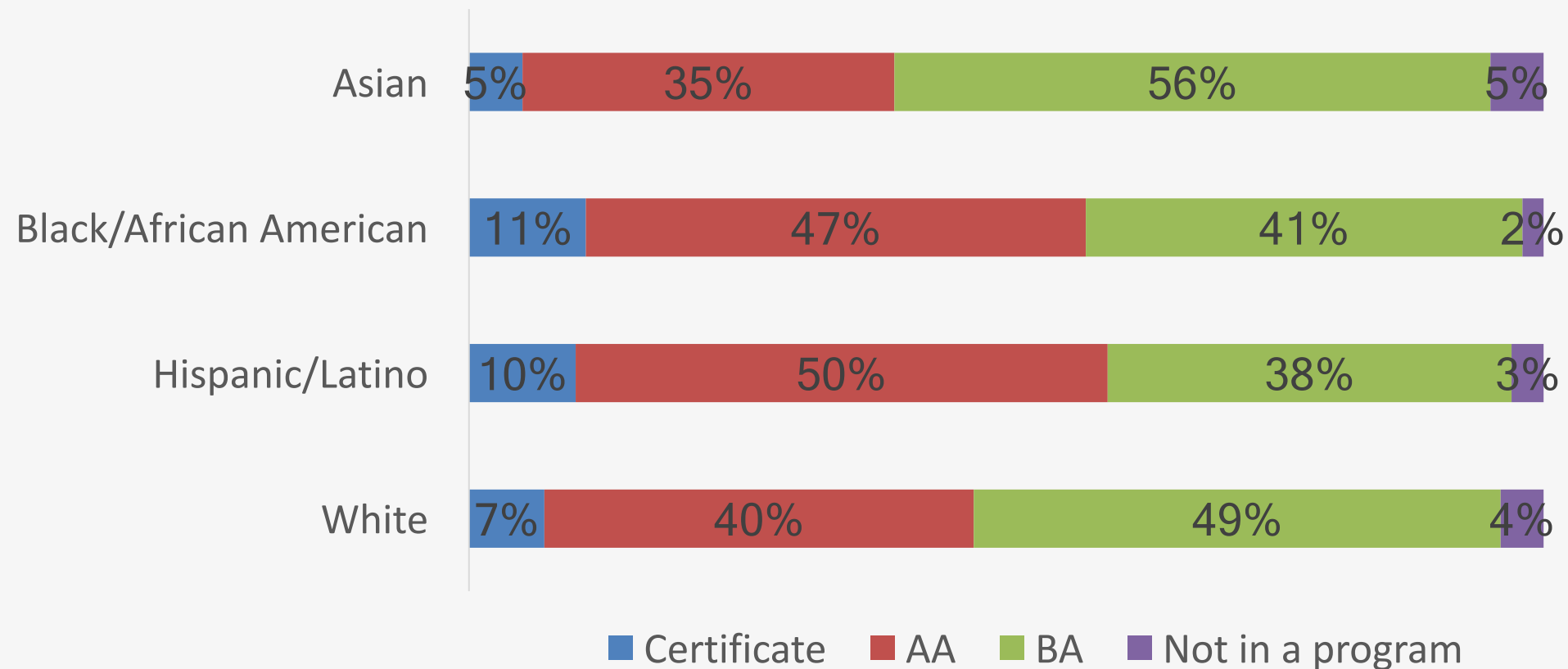
30 million good jobs that don't require a BA

Undergraduate enrollment by race/ethnicity and program

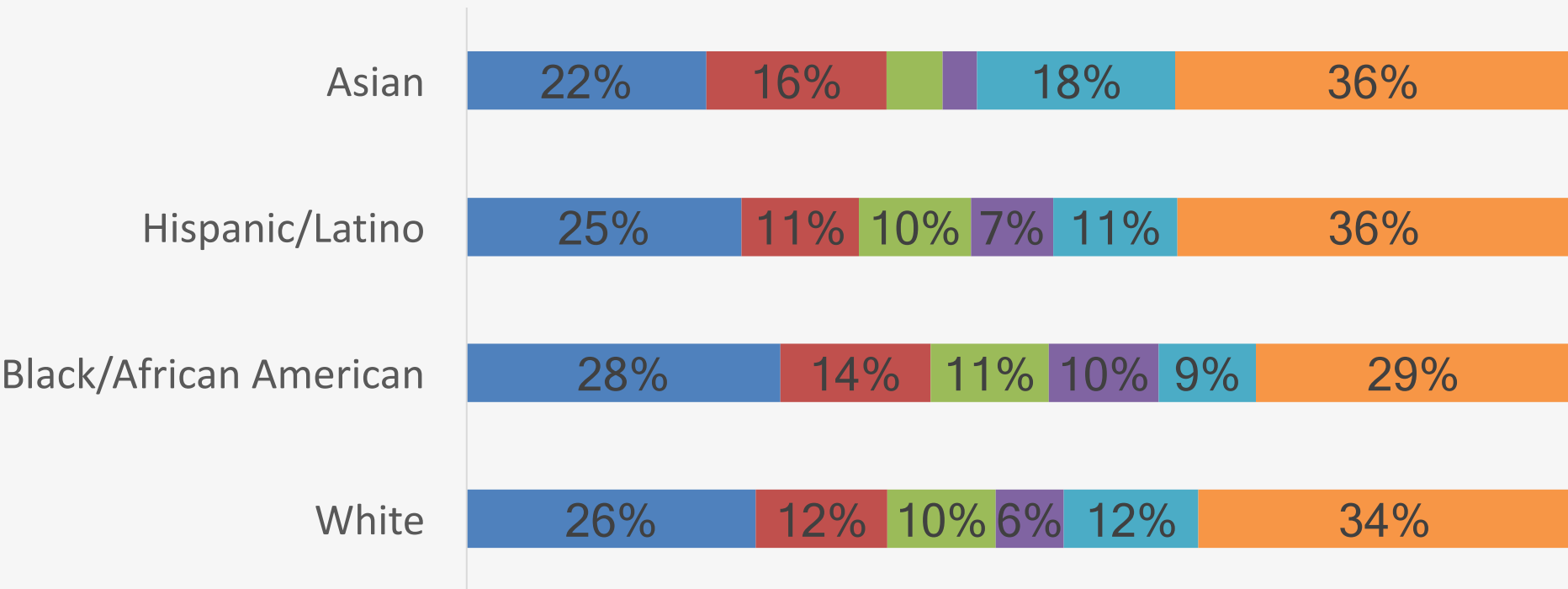
